

Oregon Aero® Pro-Tec[™] Helmet Liner Upgrade Kit Part Numbers: 95501-3, 95502-4


Installation Instructions

- Remove original pads and hook-and-loop fastening patches from the helmet shell.
- Remove as much glue as possible from the helmet shell and clean with alcohol.
- 3. Install the H-shaped nape pad first (Figure 1). Remove backing from the self-adhesive hook-and-loop strips on the pad. The hook-and-loop strips should remain attached to the pad. Position pad inside the helmet. The nape pad goes in the back of the helmet with the narrower part of the pad toward the bottom edge of the helmet shell. Align the slots of the nape pad with the two vent holes at the back of the helmet.
- 4. Next, install the star-shaped crown pad (Figure 2). The center of the star is positioned toward the rear of the helmet with the longer fingers toward the front of the helmet. Remove the backing from the self-adhesive hook-and-loop strips, as before, leaving the fasteners attached to the pad. Position the crown pad in the top of the helmet. Align the pad to clear the vent holes in the crown of the shell.
- 5. Install ear pads (Figure 3). Remove the adhesive backing from the hook-and-loop strips. Position a cushion over one ear cavity in the helmet. Orient the wider edge towards the crown and the tapered edge towards the chin strap. Press pad firmly in place, making sure the adhesive sticks to the helmet shell. Repeat this step with the opposite ear pad.

 Finally, install the brow pad (Figure 4). Remove the self-adhesive loop strip from the pad and remove the adhesive backing. Position the loop strip along the brow of the helmet and press firmly to attach. Install the pad.
